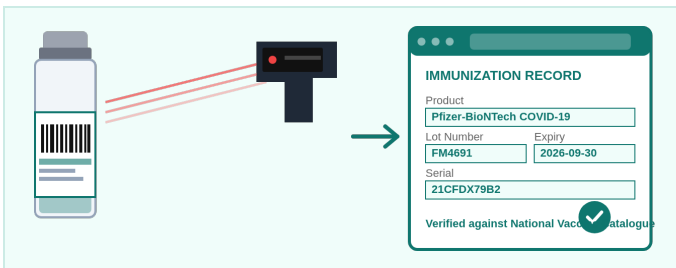


VaxLink

Vaccine barcode scanning, built right into your EMR

Wellington-Dufferin-Guelph (WDG) Public Health



VaxLink is a browser extension that captures vaccine data straight from the vial's barcode and drops it into your EMR — product, lot, expiry and serial — all validated against Canada's **National Vaccine Catalogue**.



STEP 1

Install VaxLink

Open the **Chrome Web Store** and search for **VaxLink**. Click **Add to Chrome**, then click **Install**.



STEP 2

Open your EMR

Log in to your EMR as you normally do, then **open the client record**. You'll see the **VaxLink** icon in the top-right corner of Chrome.



STEP 3

Scan the vaccine vial

Point your barcode scanner at the **barcode on the vial** and pull the trigger. That's it — **VaxLink** reads the code instantly. No typing, no squinting at tiny numbers.



STEP 4

The fields fill in for you

Product, lot number, expiry date and serial number **drop straight into the EMR form**. Have a quick look to make sure it's right, then save as usual.

KEY FEATURES

- ✓ **Privacy-first.** Scans stay on the device — nothing transmitted externally.
- ✓ **Offline capable.** Caches the National Vaccine Catalogue after setup.
- ✓ **Smart validation.** Flags expired, mismatched or unreadable vials instantly.
- ✓ **Works with web EMRs.** Tested with Panorama; adaptable to other web-based systems.

WORKFLOWS SUPPORTED

- **Single-injection charting.** Scan once and chart the dose directly.
- **Bulk inventory scanning.** Batch multiple vials and generate a manifest.
- **Mobile clinic packing lists.** Prepare accurate transport lists before the clinic.
- **Community provider ordering.** Speed up order entry for local providers.
